Visa Process	<ul> <li>application process by email.</li> <li>All documents will be sent to the university that nominated the students</li> <li>Each student must submit documents listed below to the Korean Embassy in one's country.</li> <li>a. Valid Passport</li> <li>b. Certificate of admission</li> <li>c. Business registration of the host university</li> <li>d. Completed visa application form</li> <li>e. English language proficiency	<ul> <li>f. Verification of account balance</li> <li>g. Tuberculosis Test	<ul> <li>Optional for students who stay in dormitory <ul> <li>Students may take the test before they come to Korea (within 1 month before at least) if they will stay in dormitory</li> <li>Otherwise, they can take the test after they enter South Korea, at the beginning of semester in health Center near by the campus of Keimyung University</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Health Insurance	<ul> <li>Mandatory</li> <li>International students must have national insurance of the Republic of Korea due to changed health insurance policy(about 70\$ every month)</li> </ul>
Housing	<ul> <li>Dormitory application:</li> <li>Students should apply for dormitory when they register the online application form.</li> <li>Students are requested to pay for the dormitory fee at the designated bank during the payment period after students enter the dormitory room.</li> <li>Prices (As of Fall Semester 2023)</li> <li>General Hall (2 persons / Room) <ul> <li>a. With two meals a day: KRW 1,375,000</li> <li>b. With one meal a day: KRW 1,047,000</li> <li>c.
