Language Requirements

Language of instruction at Universitas Gadjah Mada is mainly Bahasa Indonesia. However, international programs are taught in English. Specification on language requirements can be part of interinstitutional agreement. However, the general requirement is as follows:

TOEFL:550 (paper-based); IELTS: no less than 5.5; iBT: minimum 70

Living Cost	Living cost in Yogyakarta is relatively cheaper than other big cities in Indonesia. A student may expend IDR 1.500.000 – 2.500.000 per month (approximately USD 100 – 200 month) for meals, clothing, and daily expenses; exclude housing expenses.
Any other fee corresponding to fees that have to be paid by international students	Information of additional cost will be informed individually once the student received the Letter of Offer after the admission process is made.
	As per December 2021, there are a few payment details that shall be completed by

	international students namely e-Visa, Visa Authorization, Limited Stay Permit (ITAS) and Multiple Exit Re-Entry Permit (MERP), and Administration Fee. The e-Visa is billed in USD by the Government, therefore the exact amount depends on the day of the Letter of Offer issuance. Therefore, we could only give the approximate amount of fee that will be billed to students:
	6 months \rightarrow USD 350 1 year \rightarrow USD 450 2 years \rightarrow USD 600
Mentoring/buddy system	Office of International Affairs provides a buddy system for every international student. It will be announced individually by the officer prior to their arrival date.
Information About COVID-19	The positive cases of COVID-19 in Yogyakarta have decreased significantly and community activities are returning to normal. Yogyakarta shows a promising result in dealing with the pandemic by confirming 98,75% of the residents in Yogyakarta have been vaccinated. By the above accomplishment, since October 2021, the Government of Yogyakarta has opened the tourism destinations in Yogyakarta and face-to-face learning with a set of procedures applied. In addition, UGM has started a full offline learning process.
