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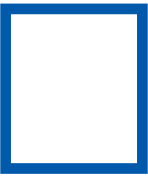
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The Keimyung Portrait, Tabula Rasa

LAPIS LAZULI

Lapis Lazuli has been one of the most highly cherished semi-precious stones in history, and ornaments made of the stone have been found at neolithic burial sites. Also mentioned many times in the Old Testament, it is known as the stone of the Ten Commandments. The deep, celestial blue color of the stone represents the educational precept of Keimyung University, “For the Kingdom of Truth, Justice, and Love.” It also reflects the will of the University to pursue the highest ideals on the basis of truth.

THE HOOPOE

The hoopoe is a bird that wears a beautiful crown. Even though it is a migratory bird, it makes itself a resident at our university. Past of Keimyung

Keimyung University traces its beginning to the Jejungwon (meaning “Salvation Hospital”), which was founded in 1899 by missionaries to provide the local populace with western medical care. Throughout its long history, Keimyung University has consistently served the community. Each member of Keimyung has played his/her role as the light of the world and helped the university to fulfil its mission to stand for truth, justice, and love.

The Keimyung Scholar

121 years of Keimyung University history has been carved in the name of truth, justice and love. Tracks laid by those who walked through our halls created the Keimyung we know today, and future scholars will use those values to pave the road to our future. Keimyung's 10 truths and 10 values are carved in 10 languages in a flat stone on campus. This reflects our university's unshakable conviction in our values and philosophy as we pursue becoming a world-class university.

The Keimyung Scholar

Keimyung University ascribes cardinal importance to 10 ontological realities and 10 existential values. The realities are: I, You, Keimyung, Neighbor, Korea, Humanity, Nature, Church, Christ, and God. The values are: Truth, Justice, Love, Community, Scholarship, Excellence, Ethics, Service, Grace, and Salvation. These 10 realities and 10 values are inscribed in the flat stone, representing the Keimyung book of learning, in the 10 languages that are taught at Keimyung University: Korean, Chinese, Japanese, English, German, French, Russian, Latin, Greek, and Hebrew. On the upper part of this stone, the very first verse of the Old Testament (“In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.”) is inscribed, while on the lower part, the very last verse of the New Testament (“The grace of the Lord Jesus be with you all.”) is engraved, both inscriptions being in Hebrew. These reflect the founding principles of the University, along with its educational precepts and objectives. The vertical stone, with its circular hole, represents the ideal Keimyung scholar, with an open heart and inner eyes, reading the Keimyung book of learning that explicates the University’s ontological realities and the existential values.

Keimyung University is proud of its long history and continues its stride forward as one of the leading universities in the country. It has recently won multiple, major government-led projects, thus consolidating its status as a world-class university.

Selected for a University Innovation Support grant to Lead the 4th Industrial Revolution

Keimyung University was selected as an autonomous improvement university by the basic competence evaluation of universities in 2019. It received a government support grant for 19.7 billion won spread over three years for a "University Innovation Support Project" supervised by the Ministry of Education and the Korea Research Foundation. This project aims to improve the basic capacity of the university and to improve the quality and preparedness of the university for the 4th industrial revolution. In addition, this project is being carried out in order to increase university innovation and growth through the process of searching for innovation activities and implementation methods for strengthening the competitiveness of the university.

Start-up Hub Supporting High Potential Entrepreneurs with Convergence Technology

Keimyung University was selected in 2011 for a project sponsored by the Small and Medium Business Administration to nurture start-up companies and was designated as a leading university for them. Keimyung has incubated 45 start-ups on campus every year since 1998 through its Start-up Incubation Center. It has also offered business capital funds and mentoring to promising start-up entrepreneurs since 2019. Additionally, the Middle and Senior Technology Start-up Center jointly run with Dalseo-gu has been recognized by the Ministry of SMEs and Startups for its excellence for six straight years.

Creation of Youth Employment Opportunities through Industry-university Collaboration

Obtaining an S Grade in the 2018 Evaluation of Youth TLO Development Project

In 2020 Keimyung University was given the highest rating of 'S' by the Ministry of Science, Technology and Communication for the implementation of the Youth TLO (Technology Licensing Office) project for a third consecutive year. Recognized for its excellence, Keimyung University was again awarded the project in 2021 with a national grant of roughly 1.5 billion won for another three years. This project seeks to employ bachelor's, master's, and doctoral graduates in the science and engineering field as hires of industry-academia cooperation. Through this project technology possessed by the university will transfer over to the private sector. A laboratory will be established to carry out this joint project. And the technology produced will be dispatched to companies in the region. Keimyung University aims to contribute to regional industrial development by cultivating experts who commercialize technology that meets the demand of local companies.

Win-win Partnership with Local Businesses: Keimyung University Won the LINC+ Project

Keimyung University was selected in 2012 for the LINC+ (Leaders in Industry/University Cooperation) project by the Ministry of Education, designed to facilitate the joint development of local universities and businesses and to develop and roll out a variety of academia-business collaboration models. Keimyung has successfully completed the first cycle (2012-2013), receiving the highest rating of 'excellent' for three consecutive years (2014-2016), and has now successfully entered the second cycle of the project. The total of the five-year (2017-2022) sponsorship amounts to about 20 billion won.

Designated as a University to Normalize High-school Education for Eight Consecutive Years

Keimyung University was selected for eight years in a row as a member of 'the project to normalize high school education' by the Ministry of Education and the Korea Council for University Education with a sponsorship totaling 7.28 billion won. This project is awarded to universities whose freshmen selection criteria are deemed to have a positive influence on high school education. Keimyung has made a continued effort to streamline its entrance qualification criteria and relieve or abolish the minimum entrance requirements of the Korea Scholastic Aptitude Test.

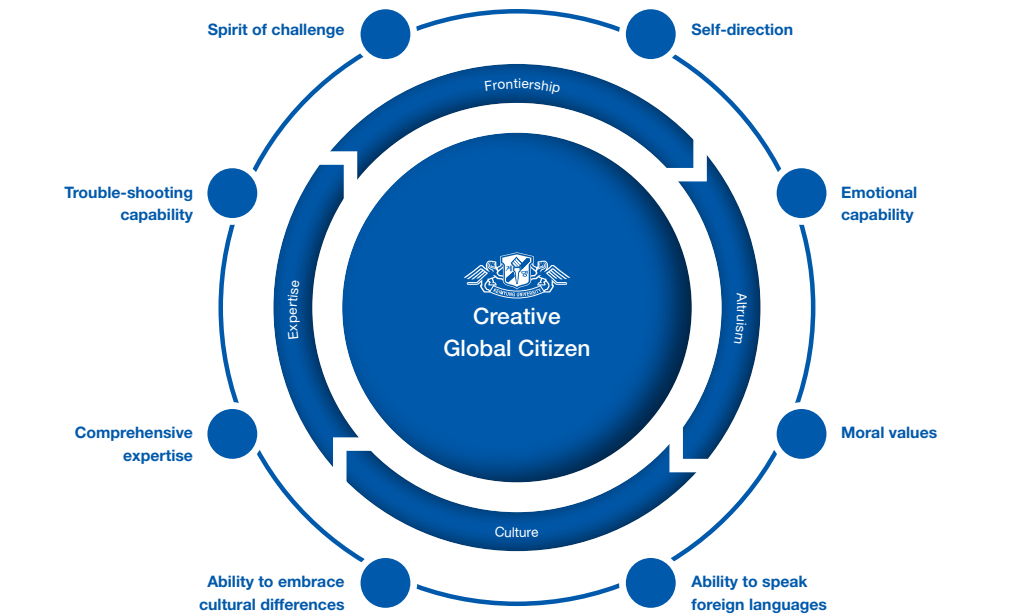

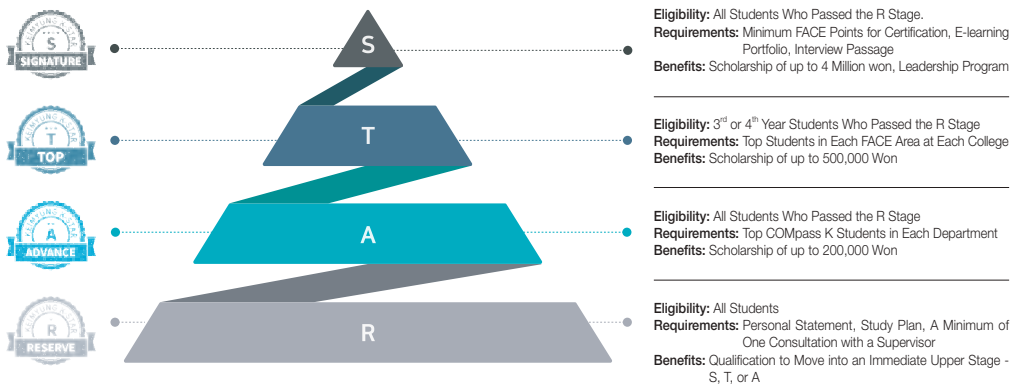

Keimyung's Effective Employment Assistance Program

Keimyung's employment assistance program provides students with personalized services to maximize their chances of employment. Keimyung manages students' career history data to provide customized job information while offering up-to-date information on employment opportunities through job fairs and jointly creating jobs in partnership with large corporations and quality local companies.

BISA Team: Leading the Development of Self-driving Vehicles

The BISA team is an academia-industry collaborative team which consists of students of the departments of Intelligent Vehicle Engineering, Electronic Engineering, and Mechanical and Automotive Engineering who work in partnership with the Center for Automotive Mechatronics Parts. The team has been conducting research on self-driving vehicle technologies since 2009. It has demonstrated outstanding achievements, winning the 2nd Daegu Mayor's Award at the 2015 Self-driving Vehicle Contest hosted by the Ministry of Trade, Industry and Energy, and receiving the Trade, Industry and Energy Minister's Award at 2015 Creative Korea, a business and technology fair. And the BISA team won Award at the 13th Hyundai Motor Group's Autonomous Vehicle Competition in 2016.

Start-up-Company-Friendly School Systems and Development of Young CEO's

Keimyung University runs a variety of programs that are considered the best in Korea for supporting creative, high potential young entrepreneurs. Its start-up company incubating arrangements range from leave of absence for starting a business to the admission of young entrepreneurs, scholarships for business start-ups, and the Graduate School of Global Entrepreneurs, thus allowing students to study and run businesses simultaneously.

Top Level Scholarship System: Bisa Scholar

Since 2009, Keimyung has offered a special scholarship called 'Bisa Scholar.' Bisa Scholar is available to any student who meets the minimum KSAT (Korea Scholastic Aptitude Test) score requirement regardless of the number of beneficiaries or specific majors. The benefits of the Bisa Scholarship include exemption of tuition fees for four years, provision of books and dormitory accommodation, designation of dedicated professors, and support for other expenses for extra-curricular learning activities inside and outside Korea. The BISA team ranked 4th at the 14th Hyundai Motor Groups Autonomous Vehicle Competition in 2019, and in February 2021, it qualified as one of six finalists out of 23 teams in the preliminary competition.

Fostering International Experts Specializing in the Textile & Fashion Industry

Keimyung University was designated in 1997 as FISEP (Fashion & International Specialist Education Program) university as part of a national project to promote specialization in local universities, and nurtures leaders in the fashion and textile industry. Having concluded exchange agreements with mid- and small-sized textile companies in Daegu, Keimyung provides students with opportunities to gain hands-on experience in the field.

Global Paradigm Leader through Vigorous Interaction between World Intellectuals

Keimyung University is establishing and solidifying its network with prestigious universities and institutions around the world. While expanding and deepening its academic links through robust exchange with world-class intellectuals, Keimyung is transforming itself into a global campus where students can work shoulder to shoulder with global talents.



A Cultural Bridge between Korea and the Rest of the World: The Energy of Keimyung

Keimyung has pioneered cultural exchanges with many countries around the world. While promoting the Korean language and culture outside Korea, the university has developed specialized research institutions to serve as bridgeheads toward other nations and regions. Keimyung University is an official test center for the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), the Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK), the Chinese language proficiency test (HSK), the Test of Russian as a Foreign Language (TORFL), and the Spanish proficiency test (SIELE).

Opening a New Silk Road Era:

The Center for Silk Road and Central Asia

The Center for Silk Road and Central Asia has been helping lay a cornerstone for mutual cooperation between Korea and Central Asian countries through academic and sociocultural exchange. The institution hosts international academic conferences every year, and publishes an international academic journal, *Acta Via Serica*, and multiple series of books as evidence of its practical and effective mutual exchange.

First in Daegu, First in Korea: Confucius Institute

Keimyung established its Confucius Institute in June 2007 with the support and cooperation of the Ministry of Chinese Education, Hanban, and Beijing Language and Culture University. Keimyung is the only university in Daegu to do so. This center pursues the harmonious development of universities and local communities through cultural and academic exchange between Korea and China. The China Center was awarded 'The Confucius Academy Award of the Year' in 2011 and 2014 for its excellent performance, and the 'Vice Prime Minister/Education Minister's Award' in 2015 for its contribution to the successful implementation of the government's education policy.

The Daegu Center for International Development

Keimyung University is home to the Daegu International Development Cooperation Center, a local branch of the Korea International Cooperation Agency(KOICA). The center's mission is to raise community awareness and involvement with international development and the Official Development Assistance (ODA) effort. The center engages in a wide spectrum of initiatives ranging from the activation of ODA projects in the local community, training to help personnel to work abroad, ODA consulting, and social responsibility activities.

The First German Culture Institute in Daegu and the Surrounding North Gyeongsang Province (Gyeongsangbuk-do): Goethe Institute Daegu

The Goethe Institute Korea is the only Goethe institute in the Daegu and Gyeongsangbuk-do area. It opened on Keimyung's Seongseo Campus in 2012. The institute plays a leading role in the promotion of German culture and the training of future German specialists. The institute selects scholarship beneficiaries from among Keimyung student every year for study in Germany.

Keimyung’s Global Campus: Meeting the Wider World Face to Face

Having signed exchange agreements with 380 universities and 48 institutions in 64 countries, Keimyung University nurtures the most extensive international exchange network of any university in Korea. Approximately 2,200 exchange students study on campus. Some 500 courses are taught in English each semester by fluent faculty members, including 149 foreign professors. On this global campus, students are nurtured to become leading global citizens.

Dual Degree Programs

Dual degree programs enable students to receive separate bachelor’s degrees from both Keimyung and one of its partner universities. The students participating in these programs study at Keimyung University for the first two years and at the partner university for the remaining two years. Once they fulfill the graduation requirements, they receive bachelor’s degrees from both schools.

Keimyung-F. Chopin Academy of Music and Keimyung-Liszt Music Institute

The Keimyung-F. Chopin Academy of Music offers bachelor’s/master’s program jointly with Keimyung’s College of Music and Performing Arts and Poland’s famed Fryderyk Chopin University of Music. The program requires students to learn from visiting professors from the Fryderyk Chopin University of Music at Keimyung for seven semesters before performing an audition at the Fryderyk Chopin University of Music in September. They can then study for three years at the Fryderyk Chopin University of Music. After they fulfill the graduation requirements, they receive a bachelor’s and master’s degree from the Fryderyk Chopin University of Music and a bachelor’s degree from Keimyung University. The Keimyung-Liszt Music Institute was established in 2010 and offers the Zoltán Kodály Method program for music teachers.

Student Exchange Program

KMU students can study for a semester or a full academic year at one of Keimyung’s international partner universities, earning credits towards their degrees in the process. Students can also choose to study at one of the ISEP and ACUCA member universities.

International Student Exchange Program (ISEP)

ISEP is a network of over 300 colleges and universities in 56 countries cooperating to provide international education for a diverse student population.

Association of Christian Universities and Colleges in Asia (ACUCA)

Keimyung, a leading member of ACUCA, actively promotes and facilitates its student exchange programs.

Semester Abroad Program

Students from the department of International and Area Studies and various departments of foreign language and literature in the College of Humanities can apply to study at one of our partner universities for a semester (approximately 16 weeks). Students are exposed to the host country’s society, culture, and language while exploring their own major.



International Lounge

Cross-Cultural Awareness Program

With the sponsorship of local government, Keimyung University has, since 2014, dispatched international students studying at Keimyung University or in Korea to elementary, middle, and high schools in the vicinity to introduce the diverse cultures of different countries to young Korean students.

Study Abroad Program (SAP)

Language and literature departments and area studies departments in the College of Humanities and International Studies provide corresponding language training programs for students. The Center for International Affairs offers English language training programs.

Keimyung Adams College (KAC)

As the third international college in Korea providing all courses in English, KAC established the majors of International Business and International Relations in 2007 and has produced specialists in international affairs with a positive and adventurous mindset. KAC offers a dual-degree program with the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, a prestigious North American university. KAC also provides students with opportunities to study at UC Berkeley during the summer vacation to deepen their knowledge in their majors, choose courses best suited to their English levels, learn a second foreign language, and participate in leadership programs.

International Lounge

The International Lounge offers a unique experience for both local and foreign students and faculty members by providing them with opportunities to participate in a wide array of cultural events. Such experiences deepen their understanding of other cultures and enhance their foreign language skills while improving their chances of employment. The Lounges language and cultural programs for the local community effectively build students’ sense of social responsibility.

Foreign-language-only Dormitories

Keimyung has three foreign language dormitories on its campus: KELI House, the first English-only dormitory in the region; (C-CLICK) House, a Chinese language dormitory; and JIKU House, a Japanese language dormitory. Keimyung students can easily learn foreign languages there, making it unnecessary to go abroad to learn a foreign language.

Korea's Heart of Representative Culture and Art

Keimyung's four seasons are full of cultural and artistic beauty. Korea's best young artists' creative minds are shared with others and world-class performances and cultural events are held all the time. Keimyung's desire to enrich society is also apparent in sports: its Taekwondo club has produced the nation's representative players who have won medals at Universiade competitions and World Championships. Keimyung is also famous for its archery team, which took first place in the 2019 World Youth Championship. A former member of the team (Chang hyejin) won two gold medals in the 2016 Rio Olympics. These are also good manifestations of Keimyung's commitment to making Korea one of the best countries for sport in the world. Keimyung's effort to enrich the world through culture and art continues into the future.

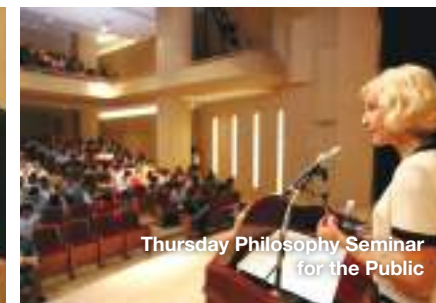

Holder of the Largest Collection of National Cultural Heritage Artifacts among Private University Libraries in Korea: Old Document Archive

Keimyung's Dongsan Library is considered 'a treasure trove of old documents', with a collection of approximately 76,000 old documents, including 21 series and 93 volumes of national treasures such as the first edition of Yongbi Eocheon Ga, (Songs of Dragons Flying to Heaven), which was compiled during the reign of King Sejong the Great as official affirmation of the Joseon dynasty and its ancestral heritage.

A Vault of Historical Treasure: Hengso Museum

The Hengso Museum has two permanent exhibition halls and one special exhibition hall and displays approximately 2,000 items out of its collection of about 20,000 pieces. The museum runs a variety of educational programs as well as special exhibitions including the "British Museum Exhibition in Daegu" and the "Chinese Treasure Exhibition."

Where Korean Tradition Lives: Keimyung Hanhakchon

Keimyung Hanhakchon, a traditional Korean village, introduces Korea's traditional culture to the world. Its liberal arts lessons and eco-cultural tradition classes are open to the local community, and international visitors to Keimyung are given opportunities to enjoy hands-on experiences of Korean tradition.

Global Performing Arts Institution: Keimyung Art Center

Keimyung Art Center, with a total floor area of 10,000m², has state-of-the-art facilities and a supersized stage. Since its opening in October, 2008, the center has served as a leading venue for world-class performances including musicals such as the "Phantom of the Opera," "Cats," and "Les Miserables."

Knowing Us and Making Us Known: Academia Koreana

Academia Koreana has greatly contributed to the development of Korean studies in the regional community: it has held regional cultural research events, domestic and international academic conferences, and special lectures. Its international Korean studies academic journal, *Acta Koreana*, is listed in Thomson-Reuters Arts and Humanities Citation Index (A&H-CI) and stands at the forefront of the globalization of Korean studies.

Expanding the Horizon of Humanities: Academia Philosophia

Since the 1980's, Keimyung University has offered philosophy seminars to the public every Thursday. In 2011, it established Keimyung Academia Philosophia to hold philosophy and humanities forums for the public every Thursday and philosophy colloquiums for university students, and to offer humanities classes to young people.

Refreshing Campus Life: Making Everyone Better

Young people are entitled to the privilege of challenging existing paradigms. Keimyung University offers a variety of opportunities for students to realize and overcome their limitations while raising their understanding of the importance of living together with other people, while encouraging them to help the less privileged, thus helping to make the world a better place for everyone.

Keimyung's Student Body

Keimyung's independent student organizations include the Student Council, the Board of Student Representatives, the Student Club Association, college-specific student councils, boards of students' representatives, and others. They hold orientations and welcoming events for freshmen, Keimyung walking parades, Bisa soccer competitions, club festivals, and the like.

Hobby Clubs

Many student clubs offer students a variety of opportunities to learn how to live in harmony in society. School-supported clubs include the Bisa cheerleading team, the mountain-climbing club, and the Taekwondo demonstration team. Over 2,000 students take an active part in 38 clubs under the 6 divisions of the student club association.

Sharing Hopes, Lighting Up the World

100% Happiness Complemented with "1% Sharing"

The entire staff and faculty of Keimyung University participate in its 1% sharing initiative, whereby they donate 1% of their pay every month until they retire. For their part, the students volunteer for outreach programs. Keimyung has been running volunteer programs such as the Keimyung Caritas overseas outreach program, the Caritas healing program (for those who need surgery or rehabilitation), and major- or department-specific overseas volunteer service.

Keimyung's Overseas Outreach Programs Participated in by 3,700 Keimyung Members for 17 Countries over the Past 18 Years

Keimyung's overseas outreach programs are designed to develop students' service spirit and international outlook and make them part of Keimyung University's effort to bring light into the world. Since the initiative for planting trees in China in 2002 to help prevent the yellow dust from spreading farther, Keimyung has continued to participate in many overseas volunteer programs to improve education in developing countries. Over the last 18 years, a total of 3,700 people from Keimyung have actively rendered volunteer service through labor, education and the performing arts in underdeveloped areas of such countries as China, Nepal, Vietnam, Mongolia, the Philippines, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, and Kazakhstan.

Medical Volunteer Program

Keimyung's Dongsan Medical Center has collected 1% of the salaries of its staff and faculty since its establishment to extend medical support to as many people as possible inside and outside Korea. The medical center actively renders medical assistance at the Kazakhstan-Almaty Dongsan Medical Center and the Nepal-Dongsan Specialized Clinic, and its medical assistance is not limited to these areas. Volunteers provide medical treatment in many other countries around the world, including Africa.

The Hub of Global Medical Sciences

Keimyung University Dongsan Hospital

Succeeding Jejungwon, which was founded 122 years ago as the western medical clinic in the region, Keimyung University Dongsan Hospital has established itself as the one of the hubs of global medical sciences. It has recently received the highest grade in 40 areas of assessment conducted by the government. It was the first institution in Asia to perform 1,000 robot-assisted surgeries, only four years after it began robot surgery. This clearly shows that Keimyung University Dongsan Hospital is now at the forefront of medicine in the region. In April 2019, it opened an eco-friendly, intelligent medical center building to provide world-class medical services.



Future Leader of Medi-City Daegu: Keimyung University Dongsan Hospital with a 'Patient First' Spirit

The Dongsan Hospital is a global hospital with state-of-the-art medical facilities, following a 'patient priority' design modelled on eight of the world's top American hospitals, including the Johns Hopkins University Hospital. It has been awarded LEED certification (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design, American eco-friendly building certification) as an energy-saving, environment-friendly building.

The top of the line Dongsan Hospital has a Cardiocerebrovascular Center and a Comprehensive Cancer Center, offering intensive treatment of severe and serious diseases. In the field of cancer treatment, the unrivaled robotic surgery technology in the Comprehensive Cancer Center is world-class. The Operation Center has the best facilities in Asia, with three robotic systems installed for the first time outside the Seoul metropolitan area. The Dongsan Hospital is a Mediplex (Medical Complex) that organically links the Medical School, the College of Nursing, the College of Pharmacy, and the Medical Science Research Building.

Possessing world-class medical facilities such as MRI, CT, PET-CT, and automatic ampul dispensing systems, Dongsan Hospital continues to uphold its founding philosophy of empathically curing and caring for its patients.

Amid the rapid spread of COVID-19 in Daegu in February 2020, Daegu Dongsan Hospital was designated by the government as a COVID-19 dedicated hospital. Keimyung University Dongsan Hospital wholly devoted itself to treating COVID-19 patients, especially serious coronavirus cases. The Dongsan Hospitals will continue to follow the founding philosophy and principles of Jejungwon and will continue to do their part as one of the most important institutions in "Medi-City" Daegu.

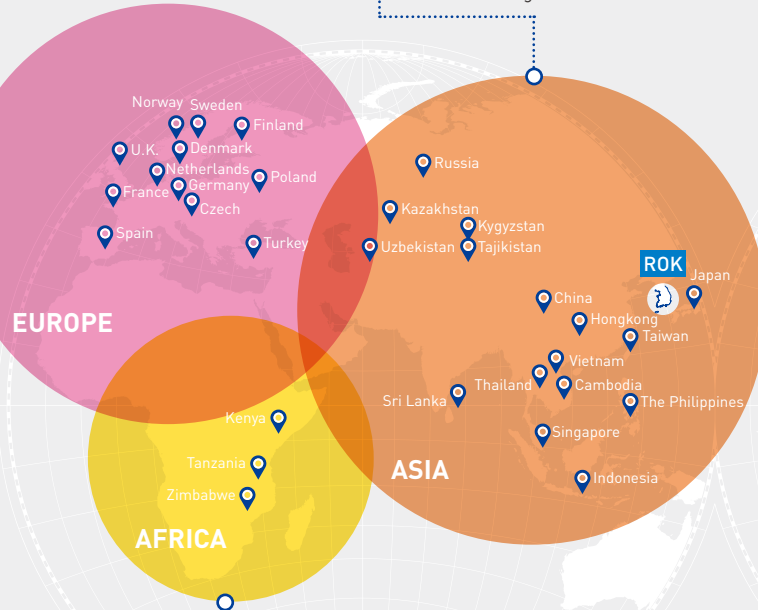

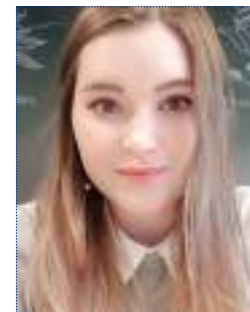
