

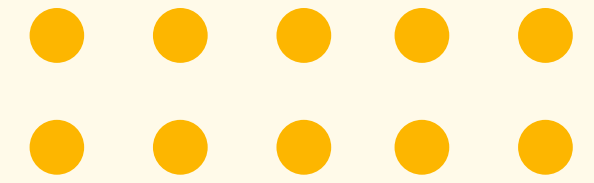

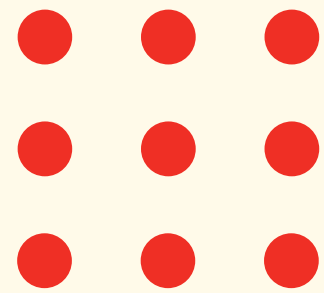

Once the nominations of the students are accepted by Mapúa University, they shall fill out the Application Form for International Programs Inbound and submit the required documents.

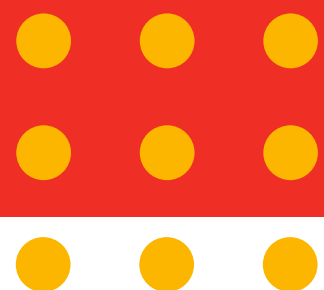
Nomination and Application Deadlines

Fall intake (August to January)

- Deadline for nominations: May 26, 2023
- Deadline for applications: June 9, 2023

Spring intake (February to July)

- Deadline for nominations: Nov. 17, 2023
- Deadline for applications: Dec. 15, 2023

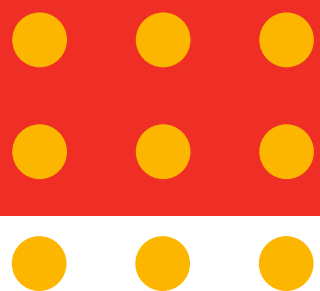

Airport Pick -up

A representative from Mapúa University's Office of International Career and Exchange Programs will pick up the students at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport upon arrival in Manila, Philippines.

Accommodation

Mapúa University does not have on - campus accommodation for international students. However, it has a list of accredited dormitories within the city and can assist international students in choosing their accommodation. The Office of International Career and Exchange Programs will send the list of accredited dormitories to the home university through email.

Student Organizations

Mapúa University has its International Students Organization, where all international students enrolled at the university get to meet, bond, and explore Mapúan and Philippine cultures together. Apart from that, Mapúa's international students' buddies, a group of Filipino Mapúans , are available to assist international students during their stay in the country. International students are welcome to join Mapúa University's various student organizations and participate in all institutional activities, such as the Foundation Week, University Week, Student Organizations Week, etc.



Cost

Tuition Fee

- For the Student Exchange Program, no academic costs are charged to the exchange students from partner universities. For non -partner universities, tuition fees vary on the length of stay and the specific courses taken.

Accommodation Rates

- **PHP 6,000.00 -PHP 20,000.00**
Depending on the type of accommodation (e.g., Dormitory or Condominium)

Food and Drinks

- Meals inclusive of food and drinks at the University Cafeteria cost **PHP 150.00**

Living Expenses

- **Php 45,000.00/month**
Includes: Transportation, groceries, and personal expenses.
